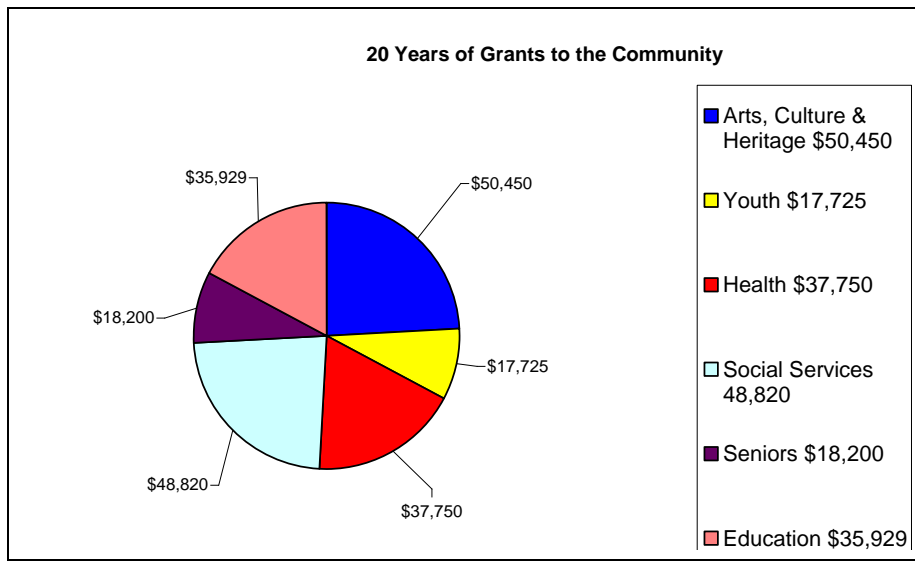

*Donations received by the Napanee District Community Foundation are invested in perpetuity. Donors have many options to choose from when considering making a charitable donation to the Foundation.*

### **Outright Gifts**

Give cash, stocks, real estate or other assets

### **Bequests** (gifts made by will)

Designate a portion of an estate

### **Charitable Remainder Trust**

Trust pays beneficiary for life and then assets transfer to community foundation

### **Life Insurance**

Donor transfers existing policy to the community foundation or assigns a new policy

### **Gifts in kind**

Artwork, private company shares etc.
